Dear Eighth Grade Parent,

The 8th grade is an amazingly exciting year for Pioneer Springs Community School! New adventures are being planned and will culminate with a Spring trip to the Barrier Islands on the SC coast! Our Fall Call to Adventure will be here soon. On September 23, we will be traveling to the Lake Norman State Park to learn about human impact on our water resources. They will have the opportunity to work with park rangers to test the water quality at the source of the region's drinking water. **All students need to bring a lunch and water bottle!**

The field trip is paid for by your child's adventure fee. **Students attending the Fall Call to Adventure Trips must have a minimum payment of \$50 submitted no later than September 20, 2019.** The final adventure fee payment will be due no later than March 1, 2020 for students attending the Spring Into the Woods Expedition. The total Adventure Fee for 2019/20 is \$200.

*We will be carpooling to Lake Norman State Park in an effort to reduce costs. The Eighth Grade will need 5 Chaperones. Parent chaperones must have attended the PSCS volunteer training, passed a background check, and provide a copy of driver's license and insurance. Please indicate your interest in chaperoning on the form below. Your child's teacher will contact you if you have been selected as a chaperone. All chaperones will be responsible for transporting students to and from the location.*
