Greetings Pioneer Families,

WHAT:

This week we kick off our first fundraiser of the 2022/2023 school year. This year we are rolling out a new concept, **Salmagundi Dundee!** Our high school students will be on teams of 8 students who will participate in the FUNdraiser by raising \$225/student. High school students will complete challenges that range from answering riddles at the General Store, a mud obstacle, a fire-making challenge, a basketball free-throw challenge, and much more! Each team can secure advantages, such as a head start or other “cheats”, by raising additional donations beyond their \$225 goal.

WHEN:

Salmagundi (go ahead look up the definition) **Dundee** (look up the Scottish definition too): Friday, December 2nd on our Pioneer campus and nearby businesses. Family members are invited to attend and cheer on our students in designated spectator areas along the course. Exact start time TBD.

WHY:

AS A GROWING CHARTER SCHOOL, FUNDRAISING IS AN ABSOLUTE NECESSITY. We do these events only a few times each year, which makes it vital to have the support of our ENTIRE community. The money we raise collectively (grades K-11th), covers the expansion and operations of our school. Our goal is \$75,000 for this event; for the year it is \$100,000.

HOW:

We are asking students to request donations from friends, family, businesses, and neighbors in the weeks leading up to the run.

All money must be collected and turned in on Wednesday, November 30th – two days BEFORE the event.

Students should collect as if they will finish the entire course and turn their money and packet in on November 30th in order to participate in the event. Each student must turn in their packet to give the consent that your family knows we are having a fundraiser.

Our fundraising projects are intentionally meaningful and empowering.

Instructions on how to donate and create a donation page.

Again, this year, we are offering an online personalized fundraising page. Individuals or siblings can combine efforts to create an easy access page to send out via social media or email to distant friends and family in your extended community.

1. Go to our website www.pioneersprings.org.
2. At the top of the homepage page, click the **Reach For the Trees/Salmagundi Dundee** drop-down.
3. Click "**Sponsor a Pi-RUN-er.**" Be ready with the picture you would like to download to your page to personalize it.
4. Choose your Team name, let your child tell their story, set the date you will stop collecting donations for Tuesday, November 29th so the numbers are in prior to the actual RUN and can be tallied by our volunteers.
5. Set your fundraising goal - while each child is asked to raise \$225, we absolutely encourage GOING BIG AND HAVING AN EVEN GREATER GOAL.
6. K-11th Choose **Individual** (not team), whether you have one child or you are combining siblings.
7. Click **GET STARTED**.
