## Collection of Devices and Instructional Materials

K-2 students will turn in school materials, including school-owned devices and chargers, during the week of May 10-14th

3-5th grade students will turn in materials during the week of May 17th- 21st  
6th-9th grade materials will be collected on May 24th

Pioneer HOME materials and devices as well as any other dropoffs will be scheduled on May 27th and 28th at the main office.

## Fuel Availability

The school is watching developments with gas supplies at this time. If your student can't get to school due to this shortage please be in touch about an attendance waiver. If conditions become such that a transition to remote learning is necessary then we will communicate those expectations at the earliest opportunity although our intention at this time is to continue in our regular schedule on campus.

## End of Grade Testing

All public schools are required to administer end-of-year testing although the state has made allowances this year in consideration of the unique challenges we've faced, including waiving the requirement to test 95% of eligible students. So that we can make a good faith effort to test students while also maintaining student safety in terms of how we use our available space, we will be inviting some students on campus next Wednesday, May 19th, to complete their testing. Staff members will shortly be in touch with those specific students to discuss this option and plan accordingly. No other students are to be on campus next Wednesday other than those contacted for testing.
