Pioneer Springs will offer 7 sports programs to upper school (7th-12th) students in the 2023-24 school year. The teams, divided into fall and spring seasons, will include boys and girls basketball, corn hole, pickle ball, cross country & trail running, disc golf, and Esports (*Rocket League* and *Fortnite*). The design of the athletic program was inspired by the school's mission, both in the sense of providing offerings that reflect a wide spectrum of interests as well as promoting sports that can be played in an outdoor setting. The school will use campus and community facilities for practices and participate in local, school-based, and league-based competitions.
