Middle School Students Explore!

Explore, a course unique to Pioneer Springs, expands academic achievement

Explore is a hands-on class designed to promote exploration and critical thinking through a variety of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) activities. Scholars in grades 6, 7 and 8 engage in four explorations and one service-based learning project each school year. Explore gives scholars an opportunity to work cooperatively with others, to practice communicating effectively with each other to solve problems, and to hone their public speaking skills through presentations. In Explore class scholars delve into a variety of topics, including Earth and Environmental Studies, Archeology, Aerospace Studies, Animal Sciences, Entrepreneurship, Architecture, Design and Engineering prior to choosing their academic focus upon entering the PSCS High School.

Extracurricular Registration Open! Join Pioneer Plus & Athletics

Pioneer Plus ... an extracurricular program providing students in grades 2-12 the opportunity to explore a wide variety of interests and activities

Pioneer Plus registration is now open! Pioneer Plus programming is intended to spark curiosity and engage students, while supporting academic growth. Fall programs begin the week of August 28th and will run every Wednesday through December 15th. Pioneer Plus is scheduled to allow students to participate both in a Pioneer Plus program and on a school athletics team.

When: Programs will be held every Wednesday from 4:00 - 5:00 from August 28th, 2023, through December 15th, 2023.

Cost: The cost is \$100.00 for the semester.

Offerings include:

Odyssey of the Mind (OM): OM teaches students how to develop and use their creativity to solve open-ended problems in a team setting. OM is a two-semester engagement with competitions in the spring. 4th through 12th grade students are eligible.

PSCS Drama: Step into the spotlight where passion, creativity, and talent collide to make performances come to life! 2nd through 12th grade students eligible.

Chess Club: Chess promotes strategic thinking, anticipation, the consideration of consequences, and confidence--all skill levels welcome. Grades 4-12th eligible.

Science Olympiad (SO): Science, technology, engineering, and math come together in high-interest events from Crime Busters to Rocket Blast Off. SO is a two-semester engagement with competitions in the spring. 4th through 12th grade students are eligible.

PSCS is pleased to offer a wide variety of competitive sports for eligible 7th-12th grade students. Athletes must be in good academic and attendance standing and are expected to attend practice two times per week in addition to competitions. The fall season will begin the week of August 28th and run through December 15th. In order to allow maximum participation in either two sports, or a sport and a Pioneer Plus program, practice days will be established based on student registration and will be communicated prior to the start of the season.

When: Practices will be held twice a week, September through December.

Cost: \$160 registration fee (includes jersey, gear, and competition fees)

What: Each team will compete in games and tournaments with other schools or leagues throughout the semester. Fall offerings include:
