*A PSCS favorite adventure with glorious mountain views, beautiful waterfalls, and plenty of opportunities to surround yourself in the amazingness of nature. Students registering for this adventure will have the opportunity to participate in monthly activities beginning in October as members of the PSCS Trailblazers Club. Activities will include backpacking classes through REI, backcountry cooking, Leave No Trace Principles, and an overnight practice campout in preparation for our big trip.
