

Pioneer Springs Parking Policy

(approved 8/19/2024)

The purpose of this policy is to serve as a guide to parking at Pioneer Springs for staff, students, and visitors to our campus. Campus parking spaces are limited and it is important that our community park in the correct zones for safety and convenience.

Visitors are invited to park at the administrative building known as “The Castle” at 9232 Bob Beatty Road.

All other campus parking zones require permits to ensure campus security and space for our staff and student parking. Vehicles without a permit in restricted areas are subject to being towed at the owner's expense.

Other restricted areas include driveways and fire lanes on campus. Parking in these areas with or without a permit is prohibited. Vehicles parked in these areas are also subject to being towed at the owner's expense.

Staff shall be provided a permit and assigned a designated parking zone at the start of each school year. The permit should be displayed on the staff's vehicle while on campus.

Student parking permits are restricted due to limited campus parking. Student parking permits are provided by lottery to PSCS students with a valid NC driver's license and proof of insurance in the following priority:

1. Seniors
2. Students with PSCS administrative approval for off-campus transportation, such as college dual enrollment, internships, or employment

A student parking lottery date shall be set annually by the school administration. Lottery applicants must apply during the lottery enrollment period.

Applicants will be disqualified if they fail to complete the application fully or submit requested documents by the lottery date.

All applicants after the lottery date shall be automatically added to the appropriate waitlist priority list. Those who do not receive a permit through the lottery will be placed on a waitlist in order of parking priority.

All applicants approved by the lottery or during the waitlist process shall pay \$100.00 per year (payable \$50.00 per semester). Permit holders must display their PSCS parking permit on the vehicle parked on campus at all times.

Parking is a privilege and the school reserves the right to revoke a student permit at any time. A student's permit may be revoked or suspended as a result of but not limited to the following:

- Repeated violation of the Behavior and Discipline Policy

- Lack of displayed permit on vehicle
- Excessive tardiness to class or school
- Reckless driving on campus or at school functions
- Walking to or sitting in a vehicle without teacher/administrator permission
- Leaving school without permission

If a student loses their permit due to any of these circumstances, they may reapply when deemed eligible and their application shall be applied to the appropriate priority waitlist.

Pioneer Springs Community School is not liable for any damages to, or theft from, or theft of, vehicles on school property, whether the result of negligence or otherwise.
