- Open enrollment is going very well. Open enrollment will close on March 1, 2024.
- Every two years, the board invests in the professional development of teachers. The academic excellence committee has decided on the following scholarship winners.

Becky introduced the following guest speakers:

Arman Casini, who is our school nurse. Arman reported:

- A pre-dental screening was done through the health department for PreK, kindergarten, and second grades. Dental Education was done for kindergarten, first, second, and fourth grades.
- PSCS partnered with Vision to Learn, a nonprofit providing students with free eye exams and glasses. They did 570 screens with 130 eye exams and gave out 112 free glasses to our students.

Cory Sperling is our CTE teacher. Corey reported:

 The high school students have been working on the garden beds on the high school side of campus. The students chose plants they would like to plant. Funding came through a grant that the students wrote. PSCS was the only school in Mecklenburg County that won the grant.
